### Science Fair

It was wonderful to see families enjoying last week's Science Fair. Thank you to our students who provided some outstanding work. This year, in excess of one third of the school population presented projects, and families acknowledged the high standard and diverse range of projects; experimental research, photography, posters, working models, videos and more. Why is night time longer in winter? Why does chocolate make you thirsty? Why do leaves change colour? What is the impact of genetically modified food? Many entries were submitted by junior classes, indicating a new norm for our school. As a byproduct of the science fair, student standards of presentation have also noticeably improved. Warm thanks to Jodie for her ongoing work with students in this area and for organising the Science Fair. Thanks also to classroom teachers who supported students in the presentation of projects. ### **Positive Behaviour for Learning**

Each week we will provide families with a quick focus on our work in Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL). Lately, our focus has been on transitioning quickly and quietly from the playground to the classroom and students have shown huge improvement in responding promptly to the bell. Our focus now is in ensuring the movement in the corridors follows our school expectation, 'Keep Left, Keep Quiet.'

### **Illness and Staffing**

There is lots of illness in our school at the moment. If your child is ill in any way, please keep them home, even if they still want to come to school. After a year of isolation and strong hygiene practice, it seems we are all more susceptible to illness. We have several staff sick at home at the moment. The challenge is in replacing these staff. We have a bank of relief staff and use two agencies but we have already had days where we have been unable to replace all staff. Many of Melbourne's relief teachers have been employed via the government's tutor program and teachers from Canada and Ireland have yet to return to Australia. Please know that we will always do our best to replace teachers, but there may be times where classes have to be split.

### Caritas

India's COVID-19 infections have surged past 20 million, nearly doubling in the past four months – marking the biggest increase in infections globally.

Caritas India, Caritas Australia's partner in India, seeks to provide food, hygiene materials and psychosocial support to the most vulnerable. The organisation is currently working to set up COVID-19 information and treatment centres to reach marginalised communities.

Through the <u>India COVID-19 Emergency Appeal</u>, you can provide immediate financial assistance to vulnerable communities impacted by this crisis.

### Service Now

In line with government guidelines we have implemented the Service Now app. This means that you should scan the code at the entrances whenever you enter the building. If you are visiting the classrooms you should come via the front office to ensure you follow the correct protocols for visitors at Holy Rosary.



### NAPLAN



Last week, our Year 3 and 5 students completed the NAPLAN tests in Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Spelling, and Numeracy. We are very proud of our students, as they approached these tests with confidence. Their 'can-do' attitude was exceptional. Well done Holy Rosary students!

Thank you to Year 3 and 5 parents who supported their children throughout this process. In order to give our students the best chance at completing these tests, we had

to rearrange our timetables. Thanks to all parents who noted these changes, and ensured their children attended school in their sport uniform on the revised PE days.

We thank our teachers who prepared the students thoroughly for the tests. Although we did not know the items on the tests or genre for writing that would be on the tests, students certainly knew how to approach tasks. Great work Holy Rosary teachers!

The results for these tests will be published in August. Parents will be sent individual results for their children. Please keep these results somewhere safe, as quite often secondary schools will ask you to provide a copy to accompany enrolment forms. NAPLAN results are not kept on the school premises and must be obtained from the VCAA.

Writing



Our major curriculum focus for 2021 is Writing. Teachers are engaged in professional learning around Writer's workshop, comprising the elements of the Writing Hour and Writer's Notebooks.





Students' interests are piqued by writing about topics they are experts in. Teachers take students through the writing process and use mentor texts to illustrate how published authors think of ideas, and how they use notebooks to develop texts.

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It's been exciting to watch children engage in this process. Check out the few examples of writing and models from our Prep

# Speech & Drama lessons 2021

Term 2

Students who would like to commence Speech & Drama Lessons in 2021 please follow the trybooking link to enrol in this program.

Speech & Drama lessons are a fun and dynamic way of building students confidence in public speaking, communication and performance skills. Speech & Drama lessons aim to improve diction, improve voice projection and develop natural expression of the spoken word.

The course will include skills such as vocal exercises, storytelling, improvisation, presentation skills and drama. Fun relaxed examinations will be undertaken as part of this program in November of each year. The extra cost of this examination will be \$30-50 depending on your child's level and by enrolling in this program you agree for your child to take part in an examination.

### **Timetabling and lesson times**

Year 1 to 6 classes are 30minutes in duration and are conducted during school hours on Fridays. To avoid missing the same class, lesson times will vary from week to week rotating on Fridays. Each student is required to bring a plastic display folder to every lesson.

### Fees for 9 Lessons per Term 2 :

Group of four or more \$206.00

### Make up lessons

It is the responsibility of the student to attend lessons, however if a student is unable to attend a timetabled lesson, a make- up lesson will be arranged where possible subject to the teacher being notified in advance. (One week's notice is required. Absences without notice will not be made up which is in line with current industrial law whereby the teacher is entitled to a full days' salary once he/she is contracted to teach.) One school terms written notice is required if enrolment is to be cancelled, or a fee equivalent to 50% of the series charge will be made, unless the withdrawal is on the recommendation of the teacher.
