### Can parents attend assemblies?

We are often asked when parents can come along to assemblies. The answer is that we don't know. Last week, we received a further COVID update which affirms current practice, and makes no change to school gatherings. As it stands now, we can only have 1 person per 2 sq m. at school or church gatherings when we invite visitors. Without visitors, we are allowed to gather as a student and staff group. As soon as there is a change to these arrangements, you will definitely be the first to know.

### Evacuation

In the coming weeks we will be preparing students and staff for a practise emergency evacuation. Students will be advised that this is a practise, in the unlikely event that we have a fire at school. When we evacuate the building we our first evacuation point is in the regular assembly area and our secondary point is in Holy Rosary Church. It would be worthwhile to reiterate with your children that these drills, are common place and to emphasise that all schools and other large buildings have regular drills.

If you are onsite at the time of an evacuation, you must evacuate with staff and students and report to the assembly area until the all clear is given by the chief warden. These events highlight the importance of all visitors reporting their presence to the front office.

### Prep students 2022

Current families should have submitted enrolments for Prep 2022 and the required documentation. Thank you to families who have promoted Holy Rosary in the community. Word of mouth is the most positive advertising of all. If you know families who are looking for Prep enrolments in 2022 please tell them to call the office for a tour.

### **Service Victoria**

Chisachi has organised the Service Victoria QR code for Holy Rosary School so that you can now register via the QR code when checking into HR. This QR code allows a great record in the case of an outbreak here at school. Please be reminded that it does not replace the sign in/out process via the iPad in the office. This process allows us to know who is in the building at any time and who has collected students.

### **NAPLAN 2021**



The NAPLAN testing window for 2021 is open from Tuesday 11 May - Friday 21 May. Our timetable for our students sitting the Naplan tests is as follows:

Tuesday 11 May: Writing Wednesday 12 May: Reading Thursday 13 May: Language Conventions Friday 14 May: Numeracy

All tests in each of the subject areas, for both Year 3 and Year 5 students, will begin at 9:30am.

We have set aside Monday 17 May and Tuesday 18 May as our 'catch-up' days with tests also beginning at 9:30am. These catch-up sessions are for students who were absent due to illness during the scheduled timetable.

All children **must** have headphones. Due to hygiene issues, children must not share headphones. We have some leftover at school from remote learning last year but not enough for everyone. It would be preferable for your children to use their own headphones, however, if this is an issue, advise your child's teacher immediately.

Headphones serve two vital purposes:

- 1. To block out the ambient noise during the test
- 2. Some of the items on the tests have audio accompanying the questions and students need to listen for the prompts



### Helpful Hints for Parents and children during NAPLAN week

1. Encourage confidence- your child will do well when they feel that 'giving the tests their best shot' is all that you expect.

 Discuss feelings and concerns: Feeling a little anxious is normal, show empathy and listen to fears. Perhaps share times when you have felt this way before tests when you went to school.
 Maintain a positive attitude: Continue to be approachable

and encourage interest in their usual after school activities. This allows children to feel safe and secure.

4. Prepare your child: Have them go to bed early, have breakfast, have a bottle of water and a **nutritious** lunch/ snacks prepared.

- 5. Arrive at school on time.
- 6. Keep Perspective: This is just a series of tests in time; just one form of assessment: success is not determined by these tests.





### FOR THE BAKERS

Any delicious cakes, slices, and biscuits are required.

Traditional stall favourites include yo yos, slices (caramel, hedgehog, lemon, rocky road), biscuits, syrup cakes, chocolate balls, brownies and unfilled sponge cakes.

### Large cakes are especially popular as well as Gluten free items.

### FOR THE PRESERVERS

Jams, curds, sweet & savoury sauces, tomato passata, relishes, pickles, pesto, etc are all brilliant sellers.

### FOR THE NON BAKERS

### FOOD SAFETY REGULATIONS

### **1. LABELLING**

**Completion of an ingredient tag is required for each item you produce.** Tags will be available after school from Monday 26th April to Wednesday 5th May, along with a 'how to' instruction guide.

#### 2. INGREDIENTS

Cakes can include cooked eggs and dairy products but must not contain any raw eggs or dairy products including cream, cream cheese or yoghurt in fillings, icing or toppings. Unfortunately we do not have refrigeration to store and sell these types of cakes.

### **3. FOOD SAFETY TIPS:** Always wash your hands before cooking

(children in particular!).

Ensure food is sealed prior to transporting from home to school (either in cellophane or in a sealed container) to prevent contamination.

### 4. PACKAGING/PRESENTATION

Experience has shown that items sell faster if they are well packaged and presented. To enhance the presentation of your delicious food, a pink and white colour scheme is used for labelling and wrapping. All packaging is supplied by the school and available after school from Mon 26th April to Wed 5th May. If you can't collect the packaging, items can be wrapped by the volunteers at time of delivery.

#### CAKES

Please place cakes on white china, white melamine or silver cake board and wrap using clear cellophane and pink ribbon. Cake boards and wrapping will be available from Monday 26th April. If you have any good condition pretty vintage plates (no chips or cracks) and pink ribbon we would welcome you wrapping with these, or donating them for use by others. Perhaps you still have your plate from last year. We would welcome the opportunity to recycle it for you. Purchasers will be able to keep their plates as well as food on them.

### SLICES

If slices are your speciality, slice boxes and doylies will be available for use. Place the slice in the box and into one of the suitably sized cello bags provided. Tie with ribbon and attach an ingredient label.

### **BISCUITS & SMALL TREATS**

Assorted cellophane bags for packaging smaller items such as biscuits, chocolate balls etc. will be available for your convenience.

### **JAM, RELISH & OTHER PRESERVES**

For the jam and relish cooks we have jars and lids available for collection from the school office. We ask you to indicate what you plan to make upon collection of the jars so that specially designed holy rosary jam/relish labels can be printed and adhered to your jars.

### DELIVERY

Please deliver items on *Friday 7th May* to the Mercy Hall *between 2:00pm and 4:30pm*.

All donations will be gratefully accepted. If you are unable to wrap but would like to contribute, we're happy to wrap for you.

If you're unable to deliver to school on Friday afternoon, you are welcome to deliver to the cake stall on Saturday morning **(before 10am)** or contact Jane or Naomi to make other arrangements. We are however encouraging earlier bakers to bring their items the day before to ensure everything is labelled correctly and priced prior to sale. This can be time consuming for those manning the stall on the day and your assistance in this regard would be greatly appreciated.

Our mother's day cake stall is a popular annual local event with many people eagerly anticipating the delicious food that will be on offer. Come along and take home a special treat to spoil mum and support Holy Rosary.

# Speech & Drama lessons 2021

### Term 2

Students who would like to commence Speech & Drama Lessons in 2021 please follow the trybooking link to enrol in this program.

Speech & Drama lessons are a fun and dynamic way of building students confidence in public speaking, communication and performance skills. Speech & Drama lessons aim to improve diction, improve voice projection and develop natural expression of the spoken word.

The course will include skills such as vocal exercises, storytelling, improvisation, presentation skills and drama. Fun relaxed examinations will be undertaken as part of this program in November of each year. The extra cost of this examination will be \$30-50 depending on your child's level and by enrolling in this program you agree for your child to take part in an examination.

### **Timetabling and lesson times**

Year 1 to 6 classes are 30minutes in duration and are conducted during school hours on Fridays. To avoid missing the same class, lesson times will vary from week to week rotating on Fridays. Each student is required to bring a plastic display folder to every lesson.

### Fees for 9 Lessons per Term 2 :

Group of four or more \$206.00

### Make up lessons

It is the responsibility of the student to attend lessons, however if a student is unable to attend a timetabled lesson, a make- up lesson will be arranged where possible subject to the teacher being notified in advance. (One week's notice is required. Absences without notice will not be made up which is in line with current industrial law whereby the teacher is entitled to a full days' salary once he/she is contracted to teach.) One school terms written notice is required if enrolment is to be cancelled, or a fee equivalent to 50% of the series charge will be made, unless the withdrawal is on the recommendation of the teacher.
