



Year 5/6 School Camp

Supervision of on-site Students During Lockdown

The major aim of this lockdown is to reduce the spread of this highly contagious variant of COVID-19 by limiting movement around Melbourne. In response we have minimal staff on site each day. In line with the Victorian Government's directive, only the following children who fit within at least one of the two categories, can attend the supervision on-site program:

Children where <u>both</u> parents and/or carers who are *Authorised Workers* and <u>cannot work from</u> home, work for an essential provider and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:

- Where there are two parents/carers, **both** must be authorised workers, <u>working outside</u> the home
- o For single parents/carers, the authorised worker must be working outside the home

Children experiencing vulnerability, including:

- children in out-of-home care
- children deemed vulnerable by a government agency (DFFH), funded family or family violence service, and is assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
- children identified by a school as vulnerable, including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service.


