Mercy Spirit Award

The students and families of Holy Rosary School were cared for by the Sisters of Mercy from 1916 until 2011. The Mercy Spirit Award was proposed by past Holy Rosary student, Alex Oswald, to honour the Mercy Sisters and to recognise the significant contribution they made to our school and parish community. The Award is usually presented annually at our Holy Rosary Day celebration in October. This year, due to COVID restrictions, it will be presented on the last day of the school year. Each recipient's name is engraved on the Holy Rosary Mercy Spirit perpetual shield that hangs outside the library.

The award is presented to two students who shine with Mercy Spirit in their everyday lives. These students display our school values of respect, integrity, resilience, relationships and kindness. They are students who help to make our school a better place by acting as Jesus' hands. The 2020 recipients were Year 6 students, Grace Cusack and Archie Oswald.

Grants

The grant process for a shade sail opens on Friday. We will make application in the hope of being granted \$25,000 towards a new shade sail to be used for outdoor learning. We have also heard that the school tutoring program will go ahead again in the new year. This year, we were able to offer a small number of children extra academic assistance and we look forward to being able to offer this again in 2022.

You may be aware that we were unsuccessful in our grant application for State and Commonwealth funding to upgrade our school buildings. We are awaiting feedback on our application from MACS and will apply again in 2022.

Review

Late last term our school was reviewed to ensure our compliance in OHS and Child Safe practices. Next week, the Reviewer will meet with staff, Fr Hien, some students and our Parish Education Board members to assist us in evaluating our current practices, and then set further goals for the next four years. Our preparation for this process has been quite rigorous and we acknowledge the significant work of staff, especially Yvette, Sonya, Maria and Ant.

2022 Class Placement Information due Tuesday

Last term we invited parents to provide information for classroom teachers to consider when compiling class lists for the year ahead. Some families have already provided this information. We remind you to share this information by Tuesday. Please share critical information for this process via the GoogleForm here. Requests for multiple friends or exclusion from multiple students cannot be accommodated. It is reasonable to request that students are not placed with siblings, cousins, close neighbours and family friends. The final decision for class placement rests with the Leadership Team and information provided by parents may guide a decision but may also be disregarded as we work for the best possible solution for all students. Late information will not be considered as this will delay our process. Please complete the GoogleForm, only if you have additional information. Otherwise, we will work to ensure your child's placement considers their academic, social and wellbeing needs.

Hats

A gentle reminder that all students need hats during daily recommended sun protection times. Sun protection times are a forecast from the Bureau of Meteorology for the time of day UV levels are forecast to reach 3 or higher. This is typically mid August- end of April. Children who do not have hats must play under the library. Hats can be ordered from Noone Uniforms.


