Mercy Spirit Award

The inaugural Mercy Spirit Award was proposed by past student, Alex Oswald, and is presented annually. The students and families of Holy Rosary School were cared for by the Sisters of Mercy from 1916 until 2011. Our annual award is presented in honour of the Mercy Sisters to recognise the legacy of all they have contributed to our school and faith community. Last year's recipients were Archie Oswald and Grace Cusack.

Two Year 6 students were recipients of the award this year; Dylan Mu and Callie Axalan. Both students are unassuming students who are quiet achievers. They maintain positive relationships with staff and students and offer to help others. They recognise that learning is their responsibility and strive to do their best. They show through words and actions that respect is their way. Congratulations Dylan and Callie.

We also acknowledged our school production cast from 'What's the Crime Mr Wolf?' They auditioned and committed to ongoing rehearsals and showed great resilience when we had to cancel the final shows.

Literacy Testing

We have set aside Monday 31 January 2022 as an assessment day. Your children will spend 20 minutes one-on-one with their teacher to assess reading. More information will be distributed to you via School Interviews Online later today.

COVID-19 Vaccines for Children

COVID-19 vaccines have been tested, and shown to be safe and effective in protecting against serious illness and reducing the likelihood of COVID-19 spreading. On 10 January 2022, children aged 5 to 11 will be eligible for COVID-19 vaccinations. These vaccinations will be available at participating general practices, pharmacies, Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisations and state vaccination centres.

The vaccine is one-third of the adult dose and will be delivered over two separate appointments, expected to be eight weeks apart. The time between the two doses can be shortened in special circumstances, such as in an outbreak response or for international travel.

The commencement of the program on 10 January 2022 provides an opportunity for all children aged 5 to 11 to receive at least one vaccine dose before they return to school, and their second dose before the end of Term 1, 2022.

Archbishop of Melbourne, Peter A Comensoli, has said that 'in our faith tradition, all the available vaccines in Australia are permissible to receive'. He has strongly encouraged the people of the Archdiocese of Melbourne to get vaccinated.

You are strongly encouraged to book your child or children in to receive their first vaccination before Term 1 begins. Vaccination is not mandatory to attend school, but it is highly encouraged to keep all children and their families safe.

How to book an appointment

Bookings will be available later in December 2021.

You will be able to book a vaccine appointment at a participating general practice, pharmacy, community health service or state vaccination centre through the Vaccine Clinic Finder.

Victorian Coronavirus Hotline

The Victorian Government's <u>Coronavirus Hotline</u> on 1800 675 398 can assist you with bookings at a general practice, pharmacy or state vaccination centre, and help with any questions you have about vaccination.

Support for students with disability or special requirements

There is extra support available for students with disability or special requirements to access COVID-19 vaccinations. The Association for Children with a Disability will hold a Facebook Live session for families of children with additional needs on Tuesday 11 January at 10.30 am. You can register online.

Team Vic Sports trials

If your child is turning ten or over next year and they are considered gifted or elite in their sporting field, you may like to enter them into the state trials to represent Victoria in the National finals next year. I have included the link below, where you can click on the sport that your child is involved in, and this will give you further information, such as when the closing date for entries is, as well as the entry requirements. "These championships offer gifted and talented students the opportunity to participate in higher levels of sporting competition against students from other Australian States and Territories. Participation in a School Sport Victoria Team Vic state team is self-funded. As a guide it may cost between \$2,000-\$3,000 to participate. Costs may include uniforms, host state levies, flights, transport, accommodation and meals. Costs will vary depending on the location of the Championship, and accommodation requirements." There are certain teams where the school can only endorse three students. The teams this applies to are 12 Years and Under Boys Australian Football, 12 Years and Under Boys Basketball, 12 Years and Under Girls Basketball, 12 Years and Under Boys Cricket, 12 Years and Under Boys Football (Soccer) and 12 Years and Under Netball. All other teams have no limit on the number of students from one school, however the Principal must still endorse a student nominated, to confirm they are gifted and talented and suited to this pathway program.

Speech & Drama lessons 2022

Students who would like to commence Speech & Drama Lessons in 2022 please follow the trybooking link to enrol in this program.

Speech & Drama lessons are a fun and dynamic way of building students confidence in public speaking, communication and performance skills. Speech & Drama lessons aim to improve diction, improve voice projection and develop natural expression of the spoken word.

The course will include skills such as vocal exercises, storytelling, improvisation, presentation skills and drama. Fun relaxed examinations will be undertaken as part of this program in November of each year. The extra cost of this examination will be \$30-50 depending on your child's level and by enrolling in this program you agree for your child to take part in an examination.

Timetabling and lesson times

Year 1 to 6 classes are 30minutes in duration and are conducted during school hours on Fridays. To avoid missing the same class, lesson times will vary from week to week rotating on Fridays. Each student is required to bring a plastic display folder to every lesson.

Fees for 8 Lessons per Term:

Group of four or more \$185.00

Make up lessons

It is the responsibility of the student to attend lessons, however if a student is unable to attend a timetabled lesson, a make- up lesson will be arranged where possible subject to the teacher being notified in advance. (One week's notice is required. Absences without notice will not be made up which is in line with current industrial law whereby the teacher is entitled to a full days' salary once he/she is contracted to teach.) One school term's written notice is required if enrollment is to be cancelled, or a fee equivalent to 50% of the series charge will be made, unless the withdrawal is on the recommendation of the teacher.

Cancellation policy

All cancellations, enquiries and correspondence to be made via email or phone to MMT ONLY. Please do not contact the school or have your child tell their teacher verbally as this information is not always passed on.

Cancellation of lessons must be done at the start of the term via email.

Lessons are only held during the week at Holy Rosary

If your child is unable to attend their lesson for any reason, MMT are to be informed prior to 9am on the day of their lesson. A credit (or cheque, if in term 4) will be given to your account if contact is made before this time. MMT do not give catch up lessons.

If students forget to bring their instrument or are sick on the day of their lesson but are present at school, they will still be required to attend their lesson. Students will cover theory and performance technique 'during' their music lesson on these days. MMT do not give catch up lessons as we teach every Monday of the term.

<u>A maximum of 2 lessons</u> can be cancelled due to sickness or holiday per term. More than two lessons away will require payment. MMT cannot hold an empty spot.
