This week through Project Compassion we learn about Shaniella who is attending a vocational school in the Solomon Islands supported by Caritas Australia Solomon Islands (CASI).

Not long after Shaniella started, the school was hit by a landslide, flooding, and a cyclone, all in quick succession.

With your kind support, CASI helped install water tanks, restoring clean water access to nearby schools, health centres and the wider community. Training was held in agricultural skills to help boost the school community's food security, as well as in environmental risk management and emergency responses.

Now, Shaniella can complete her skills training, with enough water and food to eat, and improved sanitation. She is improving her ability to earn an income, learning skills which will expand her job opportunities. Students are also better prepared to respond when disaster strikes.

**Athletics Carnival**

It's our much anticipated Athletics Carnival on Friday. Our sports captains have already jumped into action, promoting their teams and hosting house team meetings. The sound of the war cries, and the enthusiasm and excitement generated, holds us in good stead for a terrific day. We're all feeling really excited about the Athletics Carnival, and we're delighted that families can join us.

The buses for Year 3-6 students leave from 8:45am so we will have supervision from 8:20am to allow sufficient time for students and staff to get organised. Year 3-6 students who are late will need to travel with the P-2 students at 10:30am.

Here's a checklist to help your child's organisation:

**Early Departure from Athletics**

We expect that children will remain at the Athletics Day until the final scores and presentation which will be at about 2:15pm. Should you wish to take your child home directly from the Athletics, rather than letting them take the bus, you must report to your child's class teacher to sign them out. Failure to sign them out results in angst for staff and time spent looking for them, so please keep this in mind.

**Before School Supervision**

The teacher comes onto yard duty at 8:30am. TeamKids is available for care from 6:30am. Should children arrive at school in the few minutes before supervision commences they must remain seated under the library. Unsupervised play is not permitted.

## Spare Underwear

We have a supply of underwear for children in the case of a toileting issue. To help your child feel more comfortable if they have this experience, please pop some spare underwear in their bag.

## Medication

Holy Rosary School is committed to supporting students suffering from minor ailments and illnesses with the administration of prescribed medication to assist with their recovery or for the purposes of ongoing maintenance. Our [Medication Policy](#), found on our website outlines the steps parents are required to take before we can administer medication. This includes medication being provided in the original packaging and a written authorisation completed in advance. All medication must be delivered and collected by an adult.

## Class Naming Protocols

Although having consistent class names; Navy, Sky and White has been in place for some time now, the validity of this naming protocol has recently been queried. To clarify; all Catholic primary schools adopted uniform class names at the request of MACS when a new technology platform was introduced to streamline school administration.

## School Enrolments

This year our enrolments for Prep and new enrolments across the school were slightly down on the previous year which was a bumper year. However, we have maintained our overall numbers. Reports from MACS indicate that inner city primary schools have experienced a decrease in numbers. Much of this can be attributed to the trend for families to move from the inner city to more rural areas, especially the Macedon Ranges, Geelong and the Gold Coast.

## Naplan



As you are aware, The Naplan Tests are scheduled for 10-20 May. Our schedule is as follows for both Years 3 and 5:

Tuesday 10 May:	Writing
Wednesday 11 May:	Reading
Thursday 12 May:	Language Conventions
Friday 13 May:	Numeracy

All tests will begin at 9:30am and will be over by 10:30am. Should your child be absent on these days, we have scheduled makeup sessions on Monday 16 May - Wednesday 18 May, also beginning at 9:30am. As things don't always go to plan, parents will be notified of any changes to this schedule. More information will follow early Term 2. The Year 3s will complete the writing test on paper which is to be submitted as a hard copy. As has been our practice over the past three years, we will complete all other tests online.

## Return to School Term 2

All students will return to school for Term 2 on 26 April. The gate will be open at 8:30am and teachers will be on the yard to welcome children from 8:35am.







## Class Hosts

*“Without judgement, Catholic schools remain in communication with each family, tailoring the means of this dialogue so no child or family is disadvantaged...The dialogue is open and honest, and the trust and communication between the school and the family is focused on honouring the dignity of the family, the school and most importantly, of the child, ‘so they may develop as optimistic, resilient young people of faith, ready to be effective members of community, contributing to and enriching the world around them.”* Horizon’s of Hope, MACS (2018).

Holy Rosary School welcomes parents to work in partnership through the initiative of Class Hosts. This integral group of parent volunteers will actively participate in a range of social and educational activities to support the values, aims and vision of the school.

Fundamentally, Class Hosts organise a variety of events, initiatives, and work at the grassroots level to support classroom teachers and children throughout the school year. These include year level events and activities for their children’s respective year levels, and support of school events, including parent education sessions.

Therefore, the role of *Class Hosts* is to work with teachers to support the school in various ways:

- meet at the beginning of each school year to decide on the goals as Class Hosts
- join and work alongside the Social and Fundraising Group and be actively involved in their initiatives, activities and goals, and encourage other parents to participate in fundraising events
- promote the school within the wider community
- regularly communicate with classroom teachers to support endeavours in the classroom such as gathering parents to complete tasks as required by the teacher and level teachers
- provide suggestions for the newsletter and social media posts
- support the teacher with disseminating and promoting information from the school to the parent community
- welcome new families by introducing them to the parent community
- reach out to the families where English is their second language to assist their needs
- coordinate/assist with crisis support for families
- invite/promote social events for families including parent only functions of the class or year level
- assist with official parent gatherings eg. Prep 1st day of school cuppa, Year 6 Graduation dinner, plates etc.
- provide a means for parents to contribute to the development of the school’s policies and practices where required
- communicate ideas to SAC members for discussion at meetings

### Process

Parents nominate themselves as the Class Host at the beginning of the school year (however, by the end of Term 1 for the 2022 school year) by sending an expression of interest to the SAC email address [hrsac@hrkensington.catholic.edu.au](mailto:hrsac@hrkensington.catholic.edu.au). A document will be created listing all interested parents. A meeting will be convened by the principal and a SAC member where responsibilities and the scope of Class Hosts are outlined.

### What happens when no one from a grade nominates/ more than one parent nominates?

In the event that a Class Host is not assigned to a particular grade, the teacher will approach their parents and ask for a volunteer.

Parents should only nominate for one year level to give all parents an equal opportunity.

If more than one parent nominates, the group will work together. If there are more than 3 parents (for example) SAC members can coordinate a group meeting to ensure that all members are happy to be included and understand their expectations.

### What to wear

During Autumn, the mornings can be chilly, so please make sure you bring a warm top (clearly labelled) and keep an eye on the weather so your child is dressed appropriately. Some of our venues are particularly large and take time to warm up on the chillier mornings, so make sure the kids are rugged up. At TeamKids we love to get outside, so please remember to wear suitable footwear for running around.



### Double check TeamKids Room Location

It is very important to double check our website prior to attending, in case of a room change. We are sometimes required to temporarily change rooms due to school building maintenance over the school holidays. Last minute changes will be announced via SMS to attending families.



### Medical Information? Have a Plan

If your child has Asthma, Anaphylaxis, an Allergy or any other medical condition, upload plans to your TeamKids account and bring along a completed Risk Minimisation Form, found on our website. Please provide required medications to your venue coordinator on the first day of attendance - In their original packaging, clearly labelled with your child's name and a use-by date.

\*\*Please note children are unable to attend our venues without their medication and action plans.



### Receiving child care Subsidy

After your TeamKids booking is placed, you must log into your MyGov account to check you have a confirmed enrolment.
