Positive Behaviour for Learning

This week our focus is 'I wait my turn to speak.' This lesson has been introduced as teachers are noticing children calling out with greater frequency rather than raising their hand to speak. We are also drawing attention to the need to wait patiently rather than interrupting an adult or child who may be speaking with another person.

Our year 5/6 students are truly talented. We had a variety of wonderful performances; including the piano, violin, singing and the snare drums!




Year 3/4



Flemington & Kensington Bowling Club was founded in 1892 and played its first game in 1893. The club was one of the first members of the Royal Victorian Bowling Association (now Bowls Victoria) and the honour boards are filled with the names of some of Victoria's best bowlers and eminent citizens of the district.

Just a decade after the successes of the 1990s, Flem-Ken was in danger of shutting forever due to dwindling membership and falling income. But in the early 2000s a small group of members, including some new blood, began the slow process of rebuilding the club.

Their hard work, often in the face of amazing adversity, helped the club become a success again, both on and off the green. Today, the club is financially stable, has become a part of the local community again and is winning pennant flags again.

The club also has a brand new kitchen for you to check out, and continues to serve thirsty locals.

PRIVATE GOLF CLUB LOCATED IN ALTONA

The first Kooringal Members were enthusiastic pioneers, many new to the game of golf. Because of wartime shortages, they had no machines to work with, but brought their picks, shovels, hoes and hand movers to establish the first nine holes.

The Club was inaugurated at a Public Meeting at the Williamstown Town Hall on September 27, 1946, as the Williamstown Golf Club, changing its name to Kooringal in 1958, when Altona became a separate Municipality. By 1952 the full 18 holes were in play.

Kooringal's first Clubhouse was a 50-year-old former canteen building purchased from the Naval Dockyards in Williamstown and relocated at the Course in 1947. Over a period of years, many improvements and additions were made to the building, which served the Club well until it was replaced by a new state of the art Clubhouse in 1996.
