

### Advent

This Sunday marks the beginning of the new liturgical year and the first Sunday of Advent. We will be in Year A, which focuses on Matthew's Gospel.

During Advent we prepare our hearts to celebrate Jesus' birth with prayer and good works. The colour for Advent is violet. It's a colour traditionally associated with royalty because purple dye was very expensive. Violet symbolises prayer, penance and sacrifice and is also the colour for Lent.

At this time, our prayer focuses on the Advent wreath when each week we light one of four candles; three purple candles and a rose coloured candle.

The question we ask ourselves at this time is, "How do we best prepare for the coming of Jesus Christ in the busy Christmas season?"

## News from our Student Sustainability Action Group

For the last year our Student Sustainability Action Group has been doing a fabulous job collecting everybody's soft plastic using the white soft plastic bins in our classrooms. We found that people have been bringing in a lot of soft plastic in their lunchboxes.

You can see here how much we collect in a week.



Last week in our Student Sustainability Action Group meeting we found out that Red Cycle, where we take our soft plastic to be recycled, has been overwhelmed with soft plastic donations and aren't taking any more for the moment. Because of this we have taken the white soft plastic recycling bins away from the classrooms for the time being. **We ask parents to please limit the amount of soft plastic that is in your children's lunch boxes moving forward.**

We have come up with some suggestions to help to limit soft plastic in lunchboxes:

- Buy a big packet of snacks and put them into containers in lunch boxes rather than the individually wrapped packets.
- Make homemade biscuits or bars and bring them in containers rather than packaged snacks.
- Buy a big tub of yoghurt and put it into small containers rather than squeeze yoghurt pouches.

Thank you for helping reduce the plastic that might end up in landfill or our oceans.

## Peter Craig School Science Award

Last Wednesday was the 2022 Science Talent Search (STS) presentation ceremony. Students from around the state were presented with their STS awards and we heard presentations from guest scientists. This year, we had an incredible 150 students involved in class projects and another 25 students representing our school with individual projects. This was the culmination of a process that began with our school science fair back in Term Two.



Our students were awarded a total of 16 bursaries, 6 distinctions and 9 merit certificates. As a result of the outstanding achievement from our students our school was also awarded the prestigious Peter Craig award for the highest achieving non government primary school in Victoria which is an incredible achievement for our school. I am extremely proud of all our students involved and how well they represented our school.

A huge thank you to the parents who encouraged their children to enter our science fair back in May, those who took their children to the Judging Day in August and those that were able to join us for the Presentation Day last Wednesday.




**Year 5/6 Learning Overview for Term 4 Week 8 2022**

**English - The Grandest Bookshop in the World and The Writing Process**

In English, we have been consolidating reading strategies and skills through our Term 4 novel, [The Grandest Bookshop in the World](#). Students have been investigating a fantasy story about a real life family and business in Melbourne, in the late 1800s.

In Writing, the students have been working on the process of creating a piece. They begin by using their Writer's Notebook to develop a 'seed'. This is then used to commence a piece of writing. They Prewrite, Draft, Edit, Revise and Publish. Students have 1 to 1 conferences with the teacher to support and upskill their text.




## Maths - Measurement and Multiplicative Thinking

In Maths, we have been working on a unit combining measurement with multiplication and division. We have been focusing on different mental and written strategies that can be used to solve simple and complex problems. Our key focus is to build the skills towards selecting and applying efficient mental and written strategies to solve problems involving all four operations with whole numbers. In the coming weeks we will be revisiting fractions, percentages and decimals, as well as time.



## Inquiry - Creativity/Bizarre Bazaar

The focus for our Inquiry this term has been on creativity, design and innovation. Students have been exploring ways to create something appealing at a Christmas market, while raising funds for those less fortunate. Students did some market research and explored consumer wants vs needs. In groups they worked collaboratively to come up with a product idea, creating a list of items needed for their product. Students are currently making these products and will begin creating an online catalogue for browsing before the market day, on Thursday 1st December, from 2.30 - 4.00pm.



## Religious Education - Confirmation

In Religious Education this term, we have been exploring charities and people within our local community that support people in need. Sr. Kerry came and spoke to the students about the great work St. Vinnie's does in our local community and indeed throughout the whole of Melbourne. The students are soon to be involved in helping support St. Vinnies Christmas hampers as well as raising money through the Christmas Market. In the coming weeks we will be exploring the season of Advent and its importance in the Catholic Church calendar.






Alternatively, the students could do extra jobs around home to earn money to buy food. This is an invitation to give, but is purely optional.



## GETTING READY TO ATTEND...

Please ensure children are signed in no later than 9am.

### What to wear

At TeamKids we love to get outside, so please remember to pack a hat - clearly labelled and wear suitable footwear for running around. Where possible avoid wearing singlets, thongs and open-toed shoes.

Ideally, please apply sunscreen before coming to the program, and the children will reapply later in the day. If your child is susceptible or reacts to different sunscreens, please bring your own sunscreen and bring this to the attention of our educators.

The Cancer Council recommends using a high protection sunscreen (Minimum SPF 30) with a high UVA rating (4-star minimum).

### Double Check TeamKids Room Location

It is very important to double check our website prior to attending, in case of a room change. We are sometimes required to temporarily change rooms due to school building maintenance over the school holidays. Last minute changes will be announced via SMS to attending families.

### Medical Information? Have a Plan

If your child has Asthma, Anaphylaxis, an Allergy or any other medical condition, upload plans to your TeamKids account and bring along a completed Risk Minimisation Form, found on our website. Please provide required medications to your venue coordinator on the first day of attendance - In their original packaging, clearly labelled with your child's name and a use-by date.

\*\*Please note children are unable to attend our venues without their medication and action plans.

### Receiving Child Care Subsidy

After your TeamKids booking is placed, you must log into your MyGov account to check you have a confirmed enrolment.

### Extended Hours of Operation

During the school holidays, our customer service team are available from 7:00 am till 6:00 pm.

### Booking and Cancellations

Bookings are subject to availability and may be placed/ amended until the start of the session via your TeamKids online account. An additional fee of \$5 per child applies to bookings made within 7 days of attending.

Cancellations made within 48 hours of the session commencing will incur the normal fee and will be charged accordingly. Cancellations made with more than 48 hours' notice will not be charged. In the event of a medical illness, please email a medical certificate to [info@teamkids.com.au](mailto:info@teamkids.com.au) WITHIN 48 HOURS of the absence to avoid being charged for the booking. Please refer to our website for full cancellation T&Cs.

### Electronic Sign-In/Out

All TeamKids venues require electronic sign in/out. Any person signing your child in or out from TeamKids care MUST be listed on your TeamKids account and know your TeamKids account pin number, if this has been activated. These details can be updated via your TeamKids account at any time.


