Traffic

Flood Update

The hall is still not operational but it will be checked again this week. We have had a preliminary meeting regarding the roof and drainage reports and will meet again next week after a visit from engineers to make some decisions with the support of MACS representatives.

Public Address System

We've had updates to our PA system to ensure there is adequate coverage in all areas of the school, and to provide a cordless microphone for the office to enable improved communication with children when we gather in our class lines and around the flagpole.

Year 1 Outdoor Education Program

Our Year One children enjoyed a very pleasant evening last week when they participated in a billycart incursion as part of our Outdoor Education program. The idea of the program is to build on student independence and to give them an experience that prepares them for the overnight stay in Year 3. LOOK AT WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN YEAR 1

Literacy

We have been using Reader's Theatre to develop our reading fluency. In Reader's Theatre, students 'perform' by reading scripts aloud in groups. Its goal is to enhance students' reading skills and confidence by having them read with a purpose.

The Reader's Theatre scripts we are performing are:

- *Santa's Cold*
- *The Lost Reindeer*
- *Santa's Big Blunder*
- *Santa Needs to Share*

Reading fluency focuses on the following:

- **ACCURACY:** I can read the words correctly
- **RATE:** I read not too fast and not too slow
- **EXPRESSION:** I read with feeling and don't sound like a robot
- **PUNCTUATION:** I follow the punctuation marks as I read



Maths

As an end of year present to the Year 1 students, we have decided to make a contribution to the Kmart Wishing Tree on their behalf. As part of our Maths exploration, students will go on the Kmart website and use their addition and budgeting skills to figure out what presents they would like to donate.




Religion

We have been learning about Advent, the Nativity story and the true meaning of Christmas.

Since the true meaning of Christmas is hope, peace, joy and love, we wanted to focus on the giving aspect of the Christmas season, not the receiving. To assist us in our countdown to Christmas, we created 'Advent Jars'. Students brainstormed acts of kindness that can be performed in school or at home. Each day during Advent, two students will draw a piece of paper from the jar that has an act of kindness on it. Students will then perform the act of kindness they pulled out.

Next week, to give back to the community and spread some Christmas cheer, the Year 1s will be making cards for the residents at Lynch's Bridge (aged care facility in Kensington).



Inquiry

Students worked together in groups to design, build and program a 'robot' using recycled materials. This week they will present their robots to their peers.

Alternatively, the students could do extra jobs around home to earn money to buy food. This is an invitation to give, but is purely optional.


Here's what to do:



GETTING READY TO ATTEND...

Please ensure children are signed in no later than 9am.

What to wear

At TeamKids we love to get outside, so please remember to pack a hat - clearly labelled and wear suitable footwear for running around. Where possible avoid wearing singlets, thongs and open-toed shoes.

Ideally, please apply sunscreen before coming to the program, and the children will reapply later in the day. If your child is susceptible or reacts to different sunscreens, please bring your own sunscreen and bring this to the attention of our educators.

Double Check TeamKids Room Location

It is very important to double check our website prior to attending, in case of a room change. We are sometimes required to temporarily change rooms due to school building maintenance over the school holidays. Last minute changes will be announced via SMS to attending families.

Medical Information? Have a Plan

If your child has Asthma, Anaphylaxis, an Allergy or any other medical condition, upload plans to your TeamKids account and bring along a completed Risk Minimisation Form, found on our website. Please provide required medications to your venue coordinator on the first day of attendance - In their original packaging, clearly labelled with your child's name and a use-by date.

**Please note children are unable to attend our venues without their medication and action plans.

Receiving Child Care Subsidy

After your TeamKids booking is placed, you must log into your MyGov account to check you have a confirmed enrolment.

Extended Hours of Operation

During the school holidays, our customer service team are available from 7:00 am till 6:00 pm.

Booking and Cancellations

Bookings are subject to availability and may be placed/ amended until the start of the session via your TeamKids online account. An additional fee of \$5 per child applies to bookings made within 7 days of attending.

Cancellations made within 48 hours of the session commencing will incur the normal fee and will be charged accordingly. Cancellations made with more than 48 hours' notice will not be charged. In the event of a medical illness, please email a medical certificate to info@teamkids.com.au WITHIN 48 HOURS of the absence to avoid being charged for the booking. Electronic Sign-In/Out

All TeamKids venues require electronic sign in/out. Any person signing your child in or out from TeamKids care MUST be listed on your TeamKids account and know your TeamKids account pin number, if this has been activated. These details can be updated via your TeamKids account at any time.
