



Dear Parents,

This letter is to provide you with information about our school fees and levies for the 2024 school year. We value you as a member of the Holy Rosary community and appreciate the contributions you are making towards the success of our school and your child's education.

I have consulted with our Business Manager from MACS (Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools) and he recommended that we increase our fees and levies for 2024. I also acknowledge and thank School Advisory Council members for their input into our decisions. As you are aware, Holy Rosary has maintained a low fee structure for many years. Unfortunately, with increasing costs, the need for ongoing maintenance of our buildings, and the purchase of additional resources, our finances are tightly stretched. The increase in fees and levies will allow us to continue providing your children with the most up to date educational practices, technology and quality staff.

School fees in 2024 will have three components;

- 1. Family Fee
- 2. Maintenance Levy, and
- 3. Student Levies

The Family Fee and Maintenance Levy are charged per family, while Student Levies are billed for each of your children depending on their year level. The Maintenance Levy will be introduced for the first time in 2024. These funds will assist us to meet the costs associated with our new roof.

The Family Fee for 2024 will be \$2100.00 per family per year. The Maintenance Levy for 2024 will be \$150 per family per year.

To ensure our fees are affordable and that Holy Rosary School is accessible for all families the MACS Concessional Fee Policy outlines eligibility and a discounted fee structure. Concessional school fees are available from \$780 plus excursions, incursions and camps. These families may also apply for the Camp Sport and Excursion Fund (CSEF) by contacting Lynette early in 2024.

Student Levies cover the activities that your child will participate in throughout the year. Levies are per student. Levies will also increase in 2024. These levies are spent directly on curriculum needs including stationery, art materials, photocopying, excursions, camps, interschool sport, chromebooks in Years 3-6 and Operoo. As students in each year participate in different activities, the levy increases from Prep to Year 6. We have not allocated funds for the Year 6 Graduation dinner in 2024.

Using this table you can calculate your fees for the year by adding the Family Fee, Maintenance Levy and Student Levies applicable for your children. For example if your children will be in Prep and Year 2, you will pay a Family Fee of (\$2100) + maintenance fee (\$150) + Prep levy (\$750) + Year 2 levy (\$790) = \$3790 for the year.

Fees are sent as an annual invoice but there are several payment options available:

- 1. In three equal instalments by 22 March, June 21 and September 13; OR
- 2. Annual payment of fees in full by March 22; OR
- 3. Ten equal instalments from February to November on the 17th of the month
- 4. Via direct debit/electronic funds transfer in instalments that work for your family.

All fees must be paid by 30 November, 2024 unless a direct debit exists.

Your ongoing financial contribution enables us to continue to provide rich and engaging learning activities, and strong pastoral support for all students. However, we recognise that some families may be unable to meet the increase in fees. As a Catholic school we will ensure that no family is turned away through inability to pay fees. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, I strongly encourage you to book an appointment for a confidential meeting with me to make arrangements to assist your family. Holy Rosary has a strong inclusion policy and we wish to ensure the very best education for all.

Front Seat is Not a Treat

Did you know that it's safest for children under the age of 12 to sit in the back seat? Research shows that the injury risk to children aged 12 and under is nearly double in the front seat compared to the back seat, irrespective of restraint type. Holy Rosary is joining forces with Kidsafe Victoria to raise awareness and help keep children safe when travelling in the car.

As we approach the school holidays - a period that often involves time on the road - it's important to remember that the front seat is not a treat. Whether you are heading away on holiday or to the local park, it's safest for kids under the age of 12 to sit in the back seat where possible.

Booster Seats

Booster seats play an important role in reducing the risk of serious injuries for children who are too small for adult seat belts by positioning the belt where it is safest - over the bony areas of the shoulder and pelvis - rather than over the neck or abdomen. Most children won't be the right size to safely use an adult seatbelt until they are 10-12 years of age.

Kidsafe Victoria recommends using the '5-step test' to see if your child is ready to move out of a booster seat into an adult seatbelt.

5-Step Test:

- 1. Back: Can the child sit all the way back against the vehicle seat back?
- 2. Knee: Do the child's knees bend comfortably in front of the front edge of the vehicle seat?
- 3. Lap belt: Is the lap belt sitting low across the hip bones touching the thighs?
- 4. Sash belt: Does the sash (shoulder) belt sit across the middle of the shoulder, not on the neck or out near the arm?
- 5. Stay: Can the child stay seated like this for the whole trip?

A child can get a good seat belt fit if the answer to all of these 5 questions is yes. For more detailed information on choosing, installing, and using child car restraints, including access to Kidsafe Victoria's free e-learning tool, please visit www.kidsafevic.com.au/road-safety/

Lesson Plan: Being Respectful in the Church

Step 1: List Learning Intentions and Success Criteria

We are learning to: show respect in the Church, with our words and our actions.

It will look like students:

- entering the church quietly and calmly
- showing reverence and respect
- being prayerful
- sitting quietly
- singing and responding when appropriate

Step 2: List a rationale for teaching the behaviour

Why is it important?

Holy Rosary School Values: Relationships, Respect, Resilience, Integrity, Kindness (highlight relevant values) Holy Rosary School Expectations: Safety is our right. Learning is our responsibility. Respect is our way. (highlight expectation)

Step 3: Identify examples and non-examples of the desired behaviour

What would the behaviour look/sound like? What would the behaviour not look/sound like? Examples Non-examples

- Lining up in roll order
- Going to the toilet before Mass
- Waiting for your teacher to cross the road
- Walking into the church calmly and guietly
- Sitting with your class and next to others who will help you stay focused
- Singing and responding to readings
- Praying
- Responding appropriately when singing, clapping
- Actively listening to the speaker

- Running across the road to get to the church
- Talking, laughing whilst in the church
- Banging the doors
- Running down the aisles
- Sitting with your friend in another class
- Kicking, touching, tapping pew in front of you
- Long clapping and whistling, cheering, feet stamping

Speech & Drama lessons 2024

Students who would like to commence Speech & Drama Lessons in 2024 please follow the trybooking link to enroll in this program.

Speech & Drama lessons are a fun and dynamic way of building students' confidence in public speaking, communication and performance skills. Speech & Drama lessons aim to improve diction, improve voice projection, and develop natural expression of the spoken word.

The course will include skills such as vocal exercises, storytelling, improvisation, presentation skills and drama. Fun relaxed examinations will be undertaken as part of this program in November of each year. The extra cost of this examination will be \$30-50 depending on your child's level and by enrolling in this program you agree for your child to take part in an examination.

Timetabling and lesson times

Year 1 to 6 classes are 30minutes in duration and are conducted during school hours on Fridays. To avoid missing the same class, lesson times will vary from week to week rotating on Fridays. Each student is required to bring a plastic display folder to every lesson.

Fees for 8 Lessons per Term 1

Group of four or more \$195.00

Make up lessons.

It is the responsibility of the student to attend lessons, however if a student is unable to attend a timetabled lesson, a make- up lesson will be arranged where possible, subject to the teacher being notified in advance. (One week's notice is required. Absences without notice will not be made up which is in line with current industrial law whereby the teacher is entitled to a full days' salary once he/she is contracted to teach.)
