Fees

From Library 2023/24 BIG Summer Read

It is a Victorian Statewide Reading Program which will be held during 1 December 2023 - 31 January 2024.

Research has identified a phenomenon known as the 'summer slide', which refers to the loss of literacy skills over the summer holidays when children do not read—estimated on average as the equivalent of two to three months of reading proficiency. Loss of reading proficiency is most acute

in children from economically disadvantaged communities. The BIG Summer Read, developed by the Children's and Youth Services Special Interest Group (CYS SIG) aims to slow the slide by engaging children and their families in a fun and dynamic campaign supported by Beanstack, a user-friendly website (with an intuitive mobile app) that makes it easy to register, track reading and earn digital 'badges' as rewards for reaching reading milestones.

Wellbeing

At Holy Rosary School all children and families are expected to be Wellbeing Warriors who look after the safety and wellbeing of themselves and others

There is a strong case to be made for doing random acts of kindness, and an even stronger case for doing intentional acts of kindness! Helping others has been associated with a range of feel-good emotions and works towards developing positive mental health and wellbeing.

Helping others has been proven to reduce stress levels and promote feelings of happiness, calm and generosity. And it's because of these positive feelings that makes you want to help others more often. Focusing on someone else, even for a short amount of time, helps to reduce the amount of time you spend thinking about the stressors in your own life, hence leading to better mental health. The more time you devote to helping others, the more your mental health will be impacted positively.

Christmas is the perfect time to reach out to people in your community who might need support. Thinking about the communities we belong to; family, friendship groups, school, sporting clubs and local communities. During this season of Advent, we are encouraging students to use their own money to buy something for our Vinnies Christmas hampers. We understand that this is not always possible, however, we believe it would be a more powerful learning experience for our students. We talk about showing kindness through our actions at school. What better way for children to develop a better understanding of what this means and also to feel good about themselves, than through this act of service.

Lesson Plan for Positive Dispositions for Learning

Step 1: List Learning Intentions and Success Criteria

We are learning to: explain what dispositions help me to be a responsible learner and what I can do to develop those dispositions. We are learning to explain what empathy, self control and initiative mean.

What it looks like: It will look like students listing learning dispositions and explaining what they mean, what they look like and how we can use them in the classroom.

Step 2: List a rationale for teaching the behaviour

Why is it important?

Holy Rosary School Values: Relationships, Respect, Resilience, Integrity, Kindness (highlight relevant values) Holy Rosary School Expectations: Safety is our right. Learning is our responsibility. Respect is our way. (highlight)

Learning dispositions are innate in all of us, some more so than others. For example, I might be really good at seeing something that needs to be done and getting it done without being asked to. Or I might be really good at understanding other people's feelings, which then helps me to develop positive relationships with them. Dispositions help us to learn the best we can and manage ourselves and our relationships effectively.

Step 3: Identify examples and non-examples of the desired behaviour What would the behaviour look/sound like? What would the behaviour not look/sound like?

Dear Parents,

This letter is to provide you with information about our school fees and levies for the 2024 school year. We value you as a member of the Holy Rosary community and appreciate the contributions you are making towards the success of our school and your child's education.

I have consulted with our Business Manager from MACS(Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools) and he recommended that we increase our fees and levies for 2024. I also acknowledge and thank School Advisory Council members for their input into our decisions. As you are aware, Holy Rosary has maintained a low fee structure for many years. Unfortunately, with increasing costs, the need for ongoing maintenance of our buildings, and the purchase of additional resources, our finances are tightly stretched. The increase in fees and levies will allow us to continue providing your children with the most up to date educational practices, technology and quality staff.

School fees in 2024 will have three components;

- 1. Family Fee
- 2. Maintenance Levy, and
- 3. Student Levies

The Family Fee and Maintenance Levy are charged per family, while Student Levies are billed for each of your children depending on their year level. The Maintenance Levy will be introduced for the first time in 2024. These funds will assist us to meet the costs associated with our new roof.

The Family Fee for 2024 will be \$2100.00 per annum plus levies.

To ensure our fees are affordable and that Holy Rosary School is accessible for all families the MACS Concessional Fee Policy outlines eligibility and a discounted fee structure. Concessional school fees are available from \$780 plus excursions, incursions and camps. These families may also apply for the Camp Sport and Excursion Fund (CSEF) by contacting Lynette early in 2024.

Student Levies cover the activities that your child will participate in throughout the year. Levies are per student. Levies will also increase in 2024. These levies are spent directly on curriculum needs including stationery, art materials, photocopying, excursions, camps, interschool sport, chromebooks in Years 3-6 and Operoo. As students in each year participate in different activities, the levy increases from Prep to Year 6. We have not allocated funds for the Year 6 Graduation dinner in 2024.

Using this table you can calculate your fees for the year by adding the Family Fee, Maintenance Levy and Student Levies applicable for your children. For example if your children will be in Prep and Year 2, you will pay a Family Fee of (\$2100) + maintenance fee (\$150) + Prep levy (\$750) + Year 2 levy (\$790) = \$3790 for the year.

Fees are sent as an annual invoice but there are several payment options available:

- 1. In three equal instalments by 22 March, June 21 and September 13; OR
- 2. Annual payment of fees in full by March 22; OR
- 3. Ten equal instalments from February to November on the 17th of the month
- 4. Via direct debit/electronic funds transfer in instalments that work for your family.

All fees must be paid by 30 November, 2024 unless a direct debit exists.

Your ongoing financial contribution enables us to continue to provide rich and engaging learning activities, and strong pastoral support for all students. However, we recognise that some families may be unable to meet the increase in fees. As a Catholic school we will ensure that no family is turned away through inability to pay fees. If you are experiencing financial difficulties, I strongly encourage you to book an appointment for a confidential meeting with me to make arrangements to assist your family. Holy Rosary has a strong inclusion policy and we wish to ensure the very best education for all.

Speech & Drama lessons 2024

Students who would like to commence Speech & Drama Lessons in 2024 please follow the trybooking link to enroll in this program.

Speech & Drama lessons are a fun and dynamic way of building students' confidence in public speaking, communication and performance skills. Speech & Drama lessons aim to improve diction, improve voice projection, and develop natural expression of the spoken word.

The course will include skills such as vocal exercises, storytelling, improvisation, presentation skills and drama. Fun relaxed examinations will be undertaken as part of this program in November of each year. The extra cost of this examination will be \$30-50 depending on your child's level and by enrolling in this program you agree for your child to take part in an examination.

Timetabling and lesson times

Year 1 to 6 classes are 30minutes in duration and are conducted during school hours on Fridays. To avoid missing the same class, lesson times will vary from week to week rotating on Fridays. Each student is required to bring a plastic display folder to every lesson.


