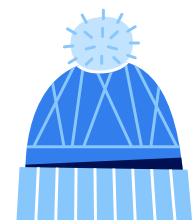
Calling all bakers and treat makers!

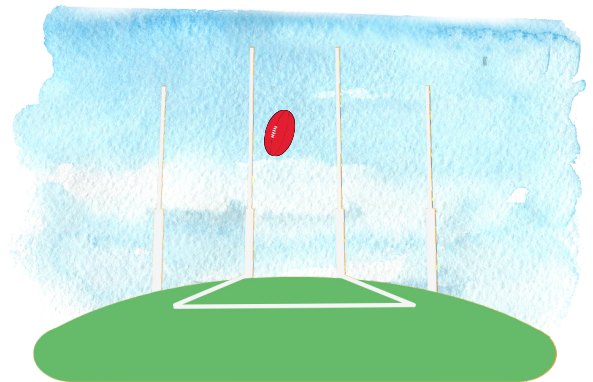

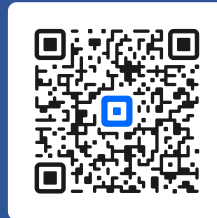

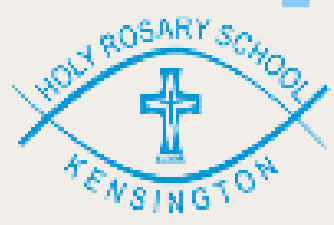

Holy Rosary Mother's Day Cake Stall 2024

Information Sheet

The annual Holy Rosary Mother's Day Cake Stall will be held on **Saturday 11 May** at **Bubba Pizza Kensington** from **9am to 12pm** unless sold out prior.

The continued success of the stall relies on the support of HR families through donations of goods and time. While we have some amazing bakers in our midst, this is **not** a prerequisite to getting involved.

There are lots of items that can be made that **don't require baking**, and there is plenty of **volunteer roles** to be filled.

Come along on the day to buy some delicious treats to support the school and our hard-working volunteers.

Items for Donation

Bakers

Any delicious cakes, slices, and biscuits. Traditional stall favourites include yo-yos, slices (caramel, hedgehog, lemon) brownies and shortbread.

Large cakes and gluten free items are very popular.

Non-Bakers

Rocky road, rumballs, truffles, no-bake slices, and lolly bags.

Preservers

Jams, curds, relishes, tomato passata, pesto and pickles (jars provided – please collect from the Front Office from the start of term 2.)

Collection/Drop off of items

School Hall – Friday 10 May 3pm – 5pm

Bubba Pizza – Saturday 11 May before 10am

Food Safety and Preparation

Labelling

Each item requires a completed ingredient tag which are provided by the school

Ingredients

Items may contain cooked eggs and dairy products however, due to a lack of refrigeration on site, **items containing raw eggs or dairy products such as cream, yoghurt or cream cheese can not be sold.**

Food Safety Tips

Ensure you **wash your hands** prior to cooking and that **food is sealed** in container or cellophane **prior to transportation.**

Volunteers

There are tasks to be completed in the lead up to the event as well as on the day.

Wednesday 24 April onwards

1. Distribute posters around Kensington, Flemington and North Melbourne. (3 volunteers)
2. Assemble packaging kits to be distributed (2 volunteers)

Monday 6 May – Thursday 9 May

1. Handing out packaging at school pick up – 3:15 -3:45pm (2 volunteers per day)

Friday 10 May

1. Collection of goods – 3:00 – 5pm (6 volunteers)

Saturday 11 May

1. Set up – 7am - 9am (6 volunteers)
2. Sell goods – 9am – 10:30pm (8 volunteers)
3. Sell goods – 10:30pm – 12pm (8 volunteers)
4. Pack up – 12pm -1pm (6 volunteers)

Packaging

All packaging items and instructions are supplied and can be collected at school pick-up from **Monday 6 to Friday 10 May.**

Jars are available from the Front Office at your convenience.

Alternatively, items can be wrapped for you by our volunteers at drop off.

The Holy Rosary Social & Fundraising Group is supported by the School Advisory Council (SAC). The Chair of the group also sits on the SAC.

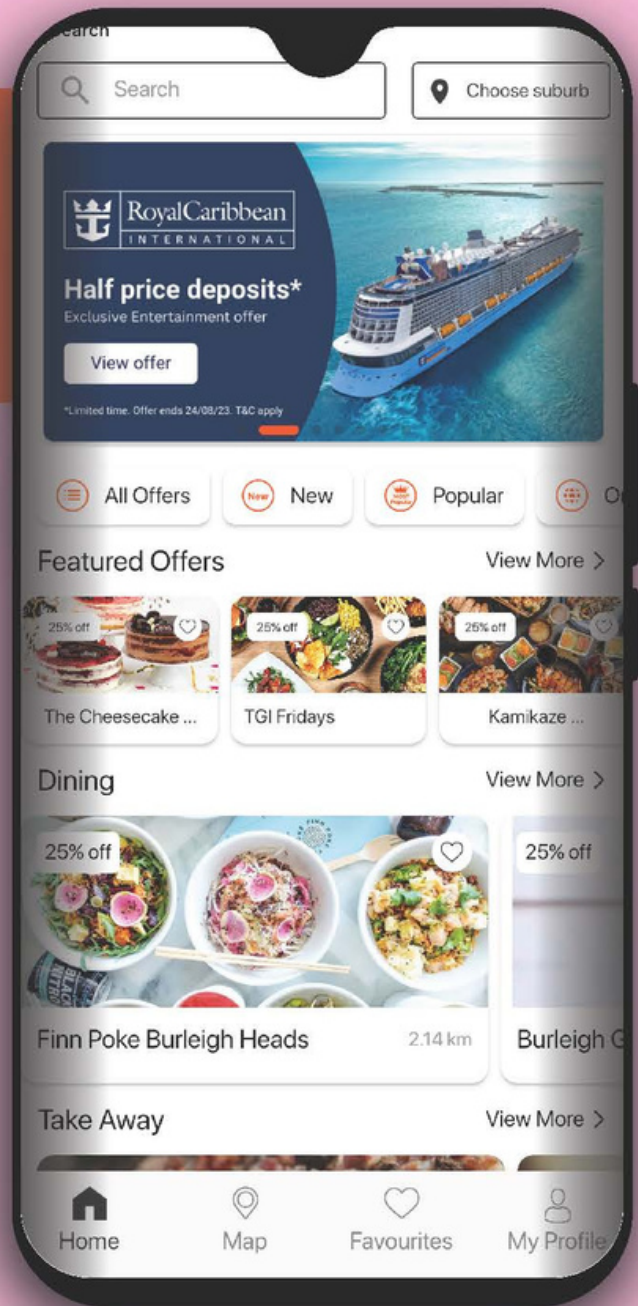
