The annual Holy Rosary Mother's Day Cake Stall will be held on Saturday 11 May at Bubba Pizza Kensington from 9am to 12pm unless sold out prior.

The continued success of the stall relies on the support of HR families through donations of goods and time. While we have some amazing bakers in our midst, this is <u>not</u> a prerequisite to getting involved.

There are lots of items that can be made that don't require baking, and there is plenty of volunteer roles to be filled.

Come along on the day to buy some delicious treats to support the school and our hard-working volunteers.

Items for Donation

Bakers

Any delicious cakes, slices, and biscuits. Traditional stall favourites include yo-yos, slices (caramel, hedgehog, lemon) brownies and shortbread. Large cakes and gluten free items are very popular.

Non-Bakers

Rocky road, rumballs, truffles, no-bake slices, and lolly bags.

Preservers

Jams, curds, relishes, tomato passata, pesto and pickles (jars provided – please collect from the Front Office from the start of term 2.)

Food Safety and Preparation

Labelling

Each item requires a completed ingredient tag which are provided by the school

Ingredients

Items may contain cooked eggs and dairy products however, due to a lack of refrigeration on site, items containing raw eggs or dairy products such as cream, yoghurt or cream cheese can not be sold.

Food Safety Tips

Ensure you wash your hands prior to cooking and that food is sealed in container or cellophane prior to transportation.

Packaging

All packaging items and instructions are supplied and can be collected at school pick-up from Monday 6 to Friday 10 May.

Jars are available from the Front Office at your convenience.

Alternatively, items can be wrapped for you by our volunteers at drop off.




SUPPORTED & INTEGRATED
